



As the adage goes "Success comes when opportunity meets preparation." A new review center in Makati is taking this saying to heart, and is preparing hundreds of aspiring Filipino nurses for success in their U.S. licensure exams popularly known as NCLEX-RN.

While barely two years old, ENTRALINK won the confidence of scores of Filipino nurses because of its rather unique review philosophy and methods. Its notable All-American team of NCLEX-RN and CGFNS Review Experts is headed by its visionary Founder and Chairman, Ann Adams who herself has had a successful 16-year career as a nursing clinician in the US. Ms. Adams has since finished her MBA from a respected U.S. university, and is now President and CEO of NC Staffing, sister company of ENTRALINK. Its breakthrough 8-day intensive review includes thoughtfully designed lectures, NCLEX style exercises, and firsthand exposure to common US supplies and equipment.

Because all reviewers live and work in the US, they possess a unique understanding of American culture and firsthand knowledge of the US nursing practice. During lectures, this unparalleled qualification translates to a firsthand look and intelligent perspective on US nursing care for students. The newly-acquired perspective gives students a point of reference in properly understanding the US healthcare setting, which is a definite edge in answering scenario-based NCLEX questions.

The combined backgrounds and expertise of ENTRALINK's reviewers are a potent mix that gives students a winning advantage which local review centers simply cannot match. As one student aptly puts it, "There is no better way to pass the NCLEX but to learn from US Experts."

The package includes a 4-month online review program, which simulates the computer adaptive test environment of NCLEX designed to build confidence and familiarity of the test. Unlike the Nursing Local Exam, NCLEX is NOT a pencil and paper-based exam, and is not comprehensive in scope. A keen understanding of the nature and purpose of the NCLEX shapes ENTRALINK's review philosophy and methods which its founder claims to be the elemental factor behind its blazing success.

With the package, students can access up-to-date "review content," reflecting the current NCLEX test plan as well as practice NCLEX-type questions as often as they wish, anywhere, anytime.

ENTRALINK's "Why Not?" critical questioning method, coupled with Harvard-developed test-taking strategies, and "review content" presented in the most easily comprehensible manner all contribute to the high success rate in the NCLEX, making ENTRALINK's battle cry of "Pass NCLEX the first time!" a reality indeed for most Filipinos.

ENTRALINK holds four reviews (February, May, August, November) a year in its Makati location. The first part of the upcoming review is from November 7-10 (Wednesday-Saturday) and the second part is from November 12-15 (Monday-Thursday). The hours are 9:00 am to 6:00 pm, every day. This set up allows for a much needed one-day break in between.

The fee is PhP24,500 VAT inclusive. With the ten percent early-bird discount, the fee is reduced to PhP22,050. To qualify for the early-bird discount for the November review, students must pay in full on or before October 1, 2007. Other discounts are also available for groups, honor students, and placers, but discounts cannot be aggregately combined. When students qualify for multiple discounts, only one will apply (whichever is the biggest).

The group discount of 15% is for enrollees in groups of three (3) or more at the time of registration and subsequent payment of fees. All group members must be listed on the registration form and must enroll for the same review month for the discount to be effective. Students will **NOT** be allowed to form groups after enrolment just so they can avail of the group discount. ENTRALINK may cancel, change or add conditions to discounts in the future. Discounts are only effective for the current review until rescinded.
